Dear Commissioner Paxon.

Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Sections 7-37-7(A) and 7-38-33(A), I issue this order setting the 2020 tax rates in the attached Certificate of Property Tax Rates (Certificate) for all governmental units imposing rates in your county.

NMSA 1978, Section 7-38-34 requires the Board of County Commissioners (Board) to issue and deliver to the County Assessor its own written order imposing these rates within five days of its receipt of this rate-setting order. Before the Board issues its order, the county is responsible for ensuring that the rates are correct, in accordance with 3.6.50.11 (D) NMAC. To further those efforts, please immediately share the Certificate with all governmental units (other than the State) that have rates included in the Certificate, so that they may also check the accuracy of their rates. In addition, please note that the "percentage change I" used as specified in NMSA 1978, Section 7-37-7.1 (A) for yield control calculations this year was 1.77%.

RE: 2020 Tax Rate change explanation

As shown on the Certificate of Property Tax Rates for 2020, the residential mill rates increased and the non-residential mill rates decreased from 2019. The following is an explanation as to why the rates changed.

Residential: For 2020, there was a 1,665,424 taxable value decrease due to valuation maintenance. This decrease explains why there is an increase in the residential tax rate. At the same time, there was a 2,053,316 increase in NET NEW value for 2020.

Non-Residential: For 2020, there was a 642,991 taxable value increase due to valuation maintenance. The valuation maintenance includes exempting a combined taxable value of \$481,506 for the T or C Schools purchase of part of AmberCare and Sierra County's purchase of the Amin's building. Also, the taxable value for livestock has decreased \$844,838 from 2019 due to reduced quantities being reported and lower livestock rates. In additional to the valuation maintenance, there was a 944,069 increase in NET NEW value for 2020.

Overall, the amount of revenue increase for 2020 is 2.76% over 2019 revenue. The tax revenue is approximately \$95,772 over last year.
