COUNTY OF SIERRA

**PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM AND REQUEST
FOR MATCH WAIVER ADMINISTERED
BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, the *County of Sierra* and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be **\$ 188,324.00** to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or **\$ 141,243.00**

and

- b. County of Sierra's proportional matching share shall be 25% or **\$ 47,081.00** if Hardship for Match Waiver is not deemed to be present by Department of Finance and Administration and the Department of Transportation

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$ 188,324.00

County of Sierra shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of **\$188,342.00**.

WHEREAS, the *County of Sierra* has a limited tax base, which limits the funding for meeting the proportional matching share; and, a fund exists in the NMDOT appropriated by the New Mexico State Legislature for Public Entities in need of "hardship" match money and *County of Sierra* requests participation in this Match Waiver Program in the amount of **\$ 47,081.00**.

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that County of Sierra determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on **December 31, 2024** and the *County of Sierra* incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW therefore, be it resolved by the *County of Sierra* to enter into Cooperative Agreement Control Number **HW2L100580** with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for year **2023 – 2024** for the re-chip seal, fog seal, pothole and shoulder repair, engineering & project management, cattleguard, drainage improvements, and road surface on various County roads to improve surface conditions. C049 Atlantic from Observatory E approx. .5 mi, Butte from NM 181 W approx. .05 mi, Market from Pacific N approx. .1 mi, Guymon from Pacific NE approx. .1 mi, Observatory from Pacific N approx. .1 mi, Pacific from NM 181 W approx. .1 mi, and B004 Berrenda from NM 7 W approx. 9 mi, within the control of the *County of Sierra* in *Truth or Consequences*, New Mexico.



The County of Sierra is interested in applying for the LGRF Hardship Match Waiver per the NM Administrative Code 18 NMAC 27.3.8 for our pending funding through the **FY 23/24** LGRF program.

NMAC 27.3.8 allows Public Entities who are experiencing financial hardship to apply for a Match Waiver of all or part of the Public Entity match normally required for participation in the Local Government Road Fund.

County of Sierra qualifies for the Match Waiver because of limited revenues and increased expenses.
